Health Resources for You and Your Family

Find help

Find Help makes it easy to find programs and available services for food, shelter, healthcare, job searching, financial assistance, and other needs. You can access the Find Help tool on the AmeriHealth Caritas DC website.

Healthy Rewards Program

Taking care of your health may pay off in more ways than one! You can earn rewards (gift cards) if you:

- Have an annual physical (for enrollees ages 9 to 20) – \$50;
- Have a prenatal care visit in your first trimester of pregnancy (before 13 weeks) – \$25;
- Have blood and urine tests if you have diabetes – \$25;
- Receive an eye exam if you have diabetes – \$25; and
- Have an appointment with your OB/GYN or midwife within one to 12 weeks (7 to 84 days) after giving birth – \$25.

NOTE: An enrollee cannot get more than \$75 in rewards each year.

Dental Benefits

AmeriHealth Caritas DC offers a comprehensive dental program that supports an integrated approach to meet enrollees' needs. Each enrollee is assigned a primary dental provider who serves as the enrollee's "dental home."

Dental health checkups and some treatments are available at no cost for AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollees younger than age 21.

Covered Services

Enrollees ages 21 and older:

- General dental exam and cleaning every six months
- Radiographs
- Surgical services and extractions
- Fillings, crowns, and sealant application
- Dentures
- Emergency dental care
- Full mouth debridement
- Prophylaxis
- Palliative treatment
- Root canal treatment
- Periodontal scaling and root planing
- Removal of impacted teeth
- Other dental services as medically necessary

Enrollees under age 21:

- General dentistry and orthodontic care for special problems
- Checkups twice a year for children ages 1 to 20
- Fluoride varnish treatment

Some procedures require pre-authorization. If you have any dental questions or need help finding a dentist, call Enrollee Services at 1-800-408-7511 (TTY 1-800-570-1190).



Enrollee Nutrition Programs

Healthy Cooking Classes

AmeriHealth Caritas DC has partnered with dietitians to offer hands-on healthy cooking classes. You'll cook a healthy meal and enjoy it after class!

How it works

- ✓ A dietitian leads a small group in a hands-on cooking session to prepare a healthy meal.
- ✓ After you cook, you'll enjoy the meal you just prepared.
- ✓ You can keep any leftovers and take home the fresh ingredients you used in class, so you can recreate your meal at home!

Nutrition Classes

We offer no-cost monthly nutrition classes that may help you change your eating habits and manage your weight.

How it works

- ✓ A health educator facilitates the class.
- ✓ You will learn skills such as budgeting for food shopping, planning meals, and making healthy food choices.
- ✓ Your facilitator also will help you find new ways to increase your physical activity.

Wellness Circles

Our Wellness Circles are open to all enrollees and can help you learn how to manage your weight and improve your overall health.

How it works

- ✓ AmeriHealth Caritas DC works with various community stakeholders to offer community classes for enrollees that take place across DC Wards.
- ✓ You'll take six classes over three months with health educators and wellness experts.
- ✓ Topics include ways to lower your blood sugar, making better food choices, menu planning, exercise, and education.

Home-Delivered Meals

At AmeriHealth Caritas DC, we believe food is a form of medicine. For this reason, we offer medically tailored home-delivered meals to enrollees who have conditions for which nutrition is a major factor in driving healthy outcomes.

How it works

We offer this program to certain enrollees in the following situations:

- ✓ Enrollees who have prediabetes or uncontrolled diabetes
- ✓ Enrollees who are pregnant
- ✓ Enrollees who have recently left the hospital
- ✓ Enrollees who are receiving treatment for hepatitis C infection

While enrolled in the program, enrollees will receive hands-on nutrition information and healthy cooking lessons.

Dietitian Services

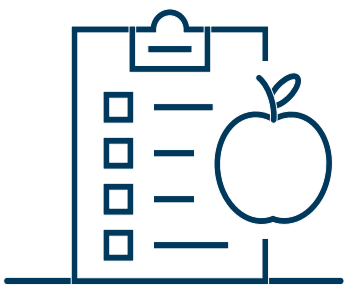
Eating right and your health go hand in hand. We offer dietitian services to eligible enrollees so they can learn the most nutritious choices for managing their health.

How it works

- ✓ Your provider or AmeriHealth Caritas DC care manager will refer you to the program.
- ✓ You will be paired with a dietitian for one-on-one sessions to help you develop a nutrition plan to manage your weight and blood sugar.
- ✓ Our dietitian will work with you to help you make individualized grocery lists and meal plans to help you meet your health needs.

Diabetes and Nutrition Resources and Programs

Online Diabetes Prevention Class

If you have prediabetes, you can take an online diabetes prevention class to learn how to manage your weight and prevent diabetes through proper nutrition.

Howard University Hospital Diabetes Treatment Center Program

The Diabetes Treatment Center at Howard University Hospital offers diabetes education classes and an online diabetes prevention class at no cost for enrollees.

- You have the option to take two types of classes at Howard University Hospital.
 - Diabetes and nutrition one-on-one classes are held Monday through Thursday every week.
 - Group diabetes education classes are held Tuesday through Thursday during the third week of every month.
- Classes focus on healthy eating, weight-loss tips, and diabetes education.

Spanish-Language Nutrition and Diabetes Classes

La Clínica del Pueblo Classes: Tomando Control de su Salud (Taking Control of Your Health)

La Clínica del Pueblo offers diabetes education classes to help you maintain your weight and nutrition while keeping a positive outlook.

- AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollees can take six-week cycles of health classes.
- Topics include fitness, goal setting, healthy eating, and medication management.

Road to Health

This six-week program helps Spanish-speaking AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollees learn how to lose weight and stay healthy.

- You'll work with health educators to learn healthier habits.
- Class topics include healthy eating, exercise, and weight-loss tips.

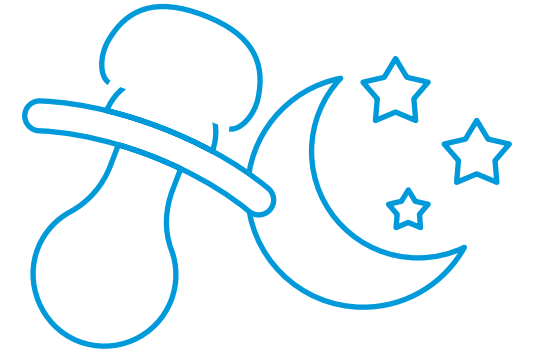
New Baby Resources

Bright Start®

Receiving early and total healthcare before your child's birth is key to helping you have a healthy baby! Bright Start is a maternity care program that helps moms-to-be make healthy choices for themselves and their unborn babies.

This program helps you:

- Find childbirth classes;
- Choose the right provider for your family;
- Get information about prenatal vitamins; and
- Find information to help you have a safe pregnancy and healthy baby.



Baby Showers

This program provides education and shares important health resources to help you have a safe pregnancy and a healthy baby. The Baby Showers program offers information to new moms and expecting moms regarding immunizations, breastfeeding, postpartum visits, child safety seats, food stipends, crib safety, and more!

Classes and Support

We work with the local organization Mamatoto Village to provide resources, classes, and support throughout your pregnancy and during and after birth. Mamatoto Village provides access to a variety of services, including breastfeeding and fitness classes, labor support, and postpartum support.

Safe Sleep

Our Safe Sleep program offers education to new parents about newborn sleeping safety.

- Monthly classes in English, Spanish, and Amharic provide resources to help you give your baby a safe sleeping environment.
- Enrollees will receive a Cribette (portable crib) at no cost upon completion of the course.

The Safe Sleep program is open to all AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollees from 36 weeks of pregnancy until six months after delivery. For more information, contact our Community Outreach Solutions team at **202-216-2318**, Monday through Friday, 8:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Urgent Care by Phone or Video Chat



AmeriHealth Caritas DC wants to help you and your family get the best care possible. We can help you decide where to go for urgent medical needs and help you get there.

If you do not think you need to be seen within 12 hours, call the Nurse Call Line at **1-877-759-6279**, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. Trained staff will help you decide whether you should go to an urgent medical care clinic, your doctor's office, or the emergency room. Talk with a Provider



A provider will review the medical history you provide and contact you within minutes. The current average callback wait time is around 30 minutes or less. A provider will listen to you to address your issue.

Common conditions treated by RelyMD:

- Allergies
- Bronchitis
- Constipation
- Cold/flu
- Diarrhea
- Ear infection
- Fever
- Joint aches and pains
- Sore throat
- Skin inflammations



Urgent Care at Home

1. Book an appointment.

DispatchHealth is available **seven days a week, including holidays, from 7:00 a.m. – 9:00 p.m.** To schedule an appointment, call **844-228-0154** or book online at www.dispatchhealth.com. A representative will ask about your symptoms and give you a time frame for arrival, typically within three hours.

2. Receive expert medical care at home.

Your DispatchHealth care team will arrive at your home with everything needed to treat your illness or injury.

3. Relax and recover.

DispatchHealth will call in any prescriptions you need, update your primary care provider, and handle billing. You can focus on rest and healing where you're most comfortable — at home.

Transportation Services



AmeriHealth Caritas DC is making it easier to live a healthier life and become the best version of yourself. With extra benefits just for our enrollees, you can get around town easier and access help to achieve your health goals.

Transportation

We believe that your health and your time are important. To give you options for easy transportation, we offer rides to provider’s appointments for all enrollees at no cost. We can fulfill same-day transportation requests for walk-in services, urgent care, and special care needs. For all other appointments, please call ahead to schedule your ride.

Call 1-800-315-3485, and a care coordinator will arrange a ride to and from your provider’s office.

Your Meds Made Easy

Many studies show that prescribed medications often are not used as directed, which can lead to potentially serious health problems. Meds Made Easy can help! If you are an AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollee, you are eligible to get certain medicines through our mail-order program or delivered to you from a participating pharmacy.

- Refill your medicines in a way that is convenient for you! You no longer need to travel to the pharmacy to refill your prescriptions or wait at the pharmacy for refills.
- Meds Made Easy offers door-to-door delivery of certain medications automatically each month.

Women’s Health

P.I.N.K.I.E. Parties

Held monthly, our P.I.N.K.I.E. Parties are interactive breast cancer education and screening events set in a fun, festive, and supportive environment. These events are held at a hospital or medical center to encourage screenings for enrollees and are designed to reduce fears and stigmas around breast cancer screening. The events include music, dancing, swag bags, healthy food, and access to health, wellness, and beauty professionals.

The Mobile Mammography Van Program

AmeriHealth Caritas DC hosts a mammography screening van once a month outside a high-volume medical center. It coordinates the mammogram appointment times to coincide with the enrollee’s annual physical exam with their primary care provider.

Family Planning

As an AmeriHealth Caritas DC enrollee, you are eligible to receive the following family planning benefits from your provider at any time:

- Pregnancy testing with the option of follow-up counseling;
- Routine and emergency contraception (birth control);
- Testing, counseling, and immunizations (including HPV); and
- Testing and preventive treatment for all sexually transmitted infections.

Asthma Prevention and Improvement Programs

Camp Breathe Happy

To help reduce the number of emergency room visits and hospitalizations for children with asthma, Breathe DC hosts Camp Breathe Happy, a summer camp to teach asthma control and self-management skills to children ages 8 to 12.

Campers are District of Columbia residents who struggle to manage and treat their asthma. During the camp, children learn how to:

- Identify their specific individual asthma triggers;
- Recognize the signs and symptoms of an impending asthmatic episode;
- Properly use medications, spacers, and peak flow meters;
- Use breathing and relaxation exercises to help alleviate asthmatic symptoms; and
- Communicate about their illness more effectively with family members, peers, teachers, school nurses, and doctors.

Breathe Easy. Start Today. (B.E.S.T.)

AmeriHealth Caritas DC provides comprehensive pharmacy benefits. Through this program, you can get your covered asthma medications directly from your provider when you visit.
